What Do We Do?

- On-Call 24/7:
 - Ground Search
 - Rescue
 - Recovery
 - Evidence Search
 - Evacuations
 - Other SO Requests
- Missions:
 - Average ~30 missions/year
- Utilize Specialized Teams

We operate in all conditions and terrains encompassed within Fremont County, from the high altitude plains in the east, to the snow covered 13ers of the Sangre De Cristo Mountains in the west, including the Royal Gorge and the waters of the Arkansas River.

High/Low Angle Technical Rope Team

Work to bring victims to safety, where rope and raising systems are required and any fall could cause an injury or worse.

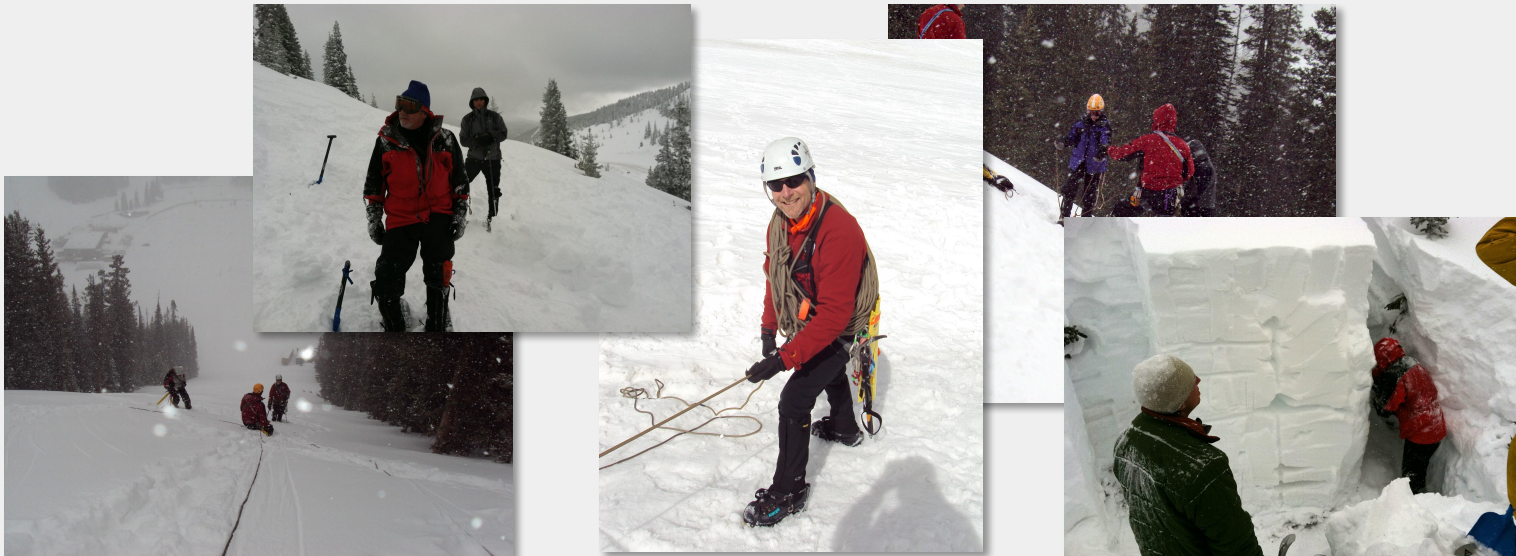

Alpine / Avalanche Team

Work at and above tree line, snow and ice. Trained in using avalanche beacons and the traditional probe line to help locate a buried victim.

Swift Water Team

Work in and on the Arkansas River, along lakes, and the edges of ponds, to locate and bring victims to safety.

Trackers & Ground Pounders

Extensive training with high-tech locating equipment (ground and aircraft), tracking and search skills to locate victims and return them to safety.

Hug-A-Tree and Survive

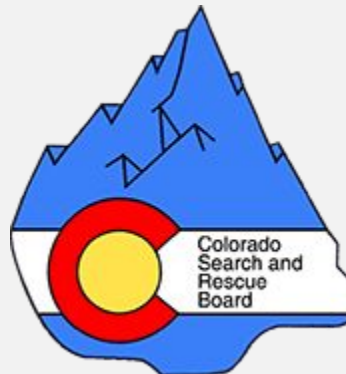
- Teach children how to survive in the woods should they become lost.
